

Grants Awarded in 2009

- Heritage Program: Campus-wide celebration of Native American culture on the campus of Arizona School for the blind, featuring Native arts and crafts, dance, music, and food
- Camp Abilities: One of the Foundation's flagship programs, Camp Abilities is a week-long summer recreation camp for blind, deaf, deaf-blind, and multiply-disabled youth from throughout Arizona.
- Specialization in Vision: Collaborative project of ASDB and University of Arizona provided intensive strength, endurance, and flexibility training for blind students with the goal of increasing the likelihood of healthy lifelong habits essential to blind people.
- International Studies for Deaf Students: Supported a European study-trip for blind students who learned
- Art Shed Program: A Foundation flagship program, Art Shed is a year-long art program for blind and low-vision students from first through 12th grades.
- Red Ribbon Week: A week-long "Say No to Drugs" campaign for deaf students at Phoenix Day School for the Deaf.
- Culinary Arts: Teaches cooking skills, nutrition, kitchen safety and healthy habits for life to blind middle- and high-school students.
- Junior Blind Olympics: Ensured all interested and qualified ASDB students were able to participate in the annual Junior Blind Olympics. ASDB traditionally has one of the largest enrollments of participants—long live the tradition!
- Childsplay Theatre: Provided exposure to six different performances at Childsplay Theatre for all K-12 deaf students at Phoenix Day School for the Deaf, allowing them to experience deaf drama and learn that deaf people are effective, artful performers.

- Arizona Hands & Voices: Supported a year-end AZHV Family Day for families of deaf children throughout Southern Arizona.
- ASDB Senior Trip: Ensured that graduating seniors from Arizona Schools for the Deaf and Blind were able to stage a senior trip, which is important not only from the standpoint of tradition, but as an important entrée into adult mobility and travel.
